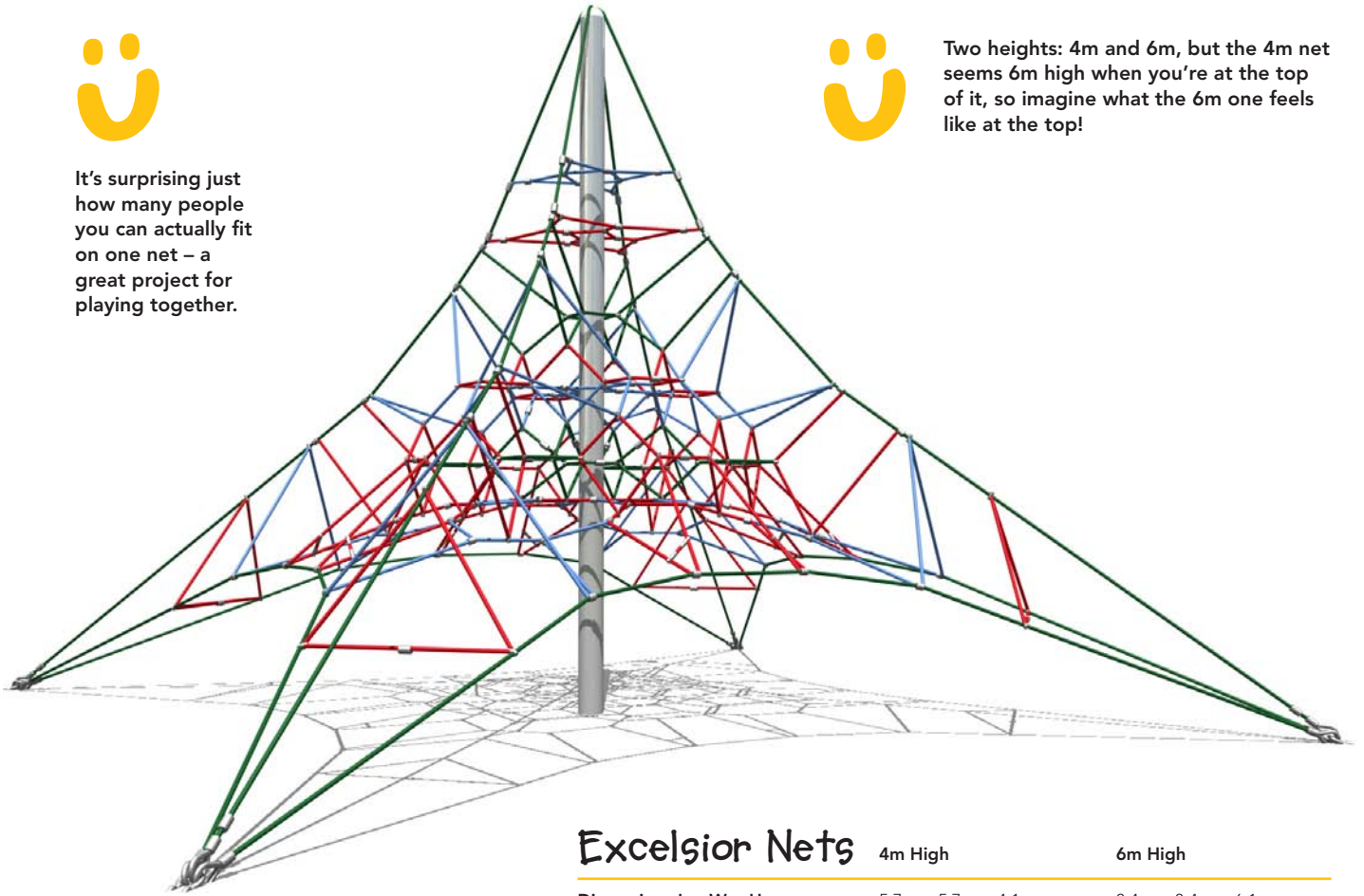




It's surprising just how many people you can actually fit on one net – a great project for playing together.

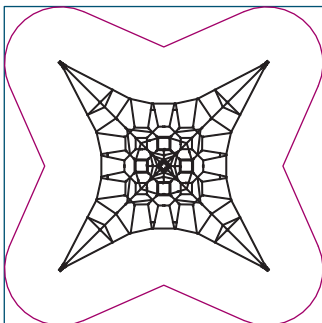


Two heights: 4m and 6m, but the 4m net seems 6m high when you're at the top of it, so imagine what the 6m one feels like at the top!



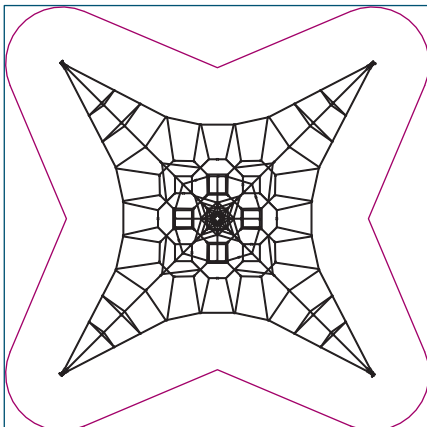
